Eligibility

- Applicant must be enrolled in a college or university.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited program of architecture, engineering, or construction management.
- Applicant must be an immediate family member of a member in good standing of the Massachusetts Building Congress (MBC), or an employee of an MBC member.

Requirements

- Applicant must complete this application form and return it with official college transcript to the MBC by October 1, 2011.
- All finalists will be interviewed by the MBC Scholarship Committee.

Awards

- Amounts will be determined by the MBC Scholarship Committee.
- Applications will be reviewed and finalists selected by the MBC Scholarship Committee, which will consider the following: academic scores, interest in construction, construction experience, extracurricular activities, and financial need.
- Winners will be notified by October 15, 2011.
- Check will be made out to applicant upon verification by Registrar's Office of the individual's current status in school.
